## **OVERVIEW**

Course: Finance and Credit

Degree: Bachelor Course Duration – 4 years

**Description:** The programme is designed to meet the educational needs of individuals, the society and the state as well as to develop common education space in the field of finance and credit.

The programme is aimed at training highly skilled professionals in the field of finance and credit, many-sided development of trainees, and training for cultural and professional competences in compliance with the requirements of the Federal State Educational Standard for Higher Education on Bachelor's Degree Programme 080100.62 in Economics.

Bachelor's Degree Programme 080100.62 in Economics best serves those students who are willing to get involved in such professional activities as economic, analytical, research, and managerial ones.

**Programme Department:** The Department of Finance and Fiscal Policy of the Business Faculty is in charge of the programme.

**Teaching Staff:** The teaching staff of the department comprises professors, assistant professors, and dedicated expert practitioners (financial and investment advisers, auditors, accountants, inspectors, and others). Training is delivered by academic staff members who have in-field qualifications for the subjects taught, they do research and are engaged in methodological activity. More than 60 per cent of the teaching staff members hold scholastic degrees and academic ranks, not less than 8 per cent of the teachers holding doctor's degrees or professor academic ranks.

## **Study Facilities.**

The programme is supported with procedural documentation and teaching materials for all course subjects. Apart from course books the stock of further readings includes official, reference and dedicated periodicals. Technical support is ensured with the help of computer training devices, simulators, and software (Project Expert, 1C, Kontur, Nalogoplatelschik YuL, SPSS, Consultant Plus, Garant, and others), and others.

**Career Opportunities.** Graduates have employment opportunities in organizations (and operating units) of private sector in the field of finance and credit (banks, finance, insurance, investment, auditing and manufacturing companies, and others), in operating units of budgetary institutions, self-governing and nonprofit organizations.
